These programs are led by our professional youth development staff, but community volunteers (age 18 and up) provide much needed support in these programs, as well as offer our members access to more positive adult role models who want to see them succeed.

Whether you have a specific skill set, or just want to be a role model for the youth in Lowell who need you most, volunteering at the Boys & Girls Club will not only change a young person life, but yours as well.
