Connecting your fundraiser to your Facebook page is an easy way for donors to give in a format they are likely very used to.

Also, Facebook passes 100% of the donation along to the Club – there are no platform or credit card fees to pay.



Log into your Fundraising page

<u>Do not</u> select these buttons – this simply shares your Qgiv page on Facebook.


Instead, scroll down further on the page.

When you click the "Connect your fundraiser to Facebook button" this screen will appear. Give your fundraiser a name, and fill in the description.

When you are ready, click "Connect to Facebook"




You might want to make the description different from the personal story you created on your fundraising page, as both will show up in your Facebook fundraiser.

Once you are connected to Facebook, you will see a screen that looks like this. This is your Facebook fundraiser, which is on your personal fundraising page.




This image will automatically show up on your page, but you can change it by selecting the edit button.

Your Facebook fundraiser is now ready. The next step (and most important) is to share and invite people to join your fundraiser.



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Invite your friends to donate by clicking the "Invite" button, and selecting friends from the




To share your fundraiser on your page, click the "Share" button and write a post asking folks to support your fundraiser.

It is recommended that you continue to share your fundraiser on a regular basis, as not everyone will see it each time you share, nor will it stay at the top of your friend's feed for very long.
