Secure your Legacy and Make the Most of Your Giving Before Tax Laws Shift

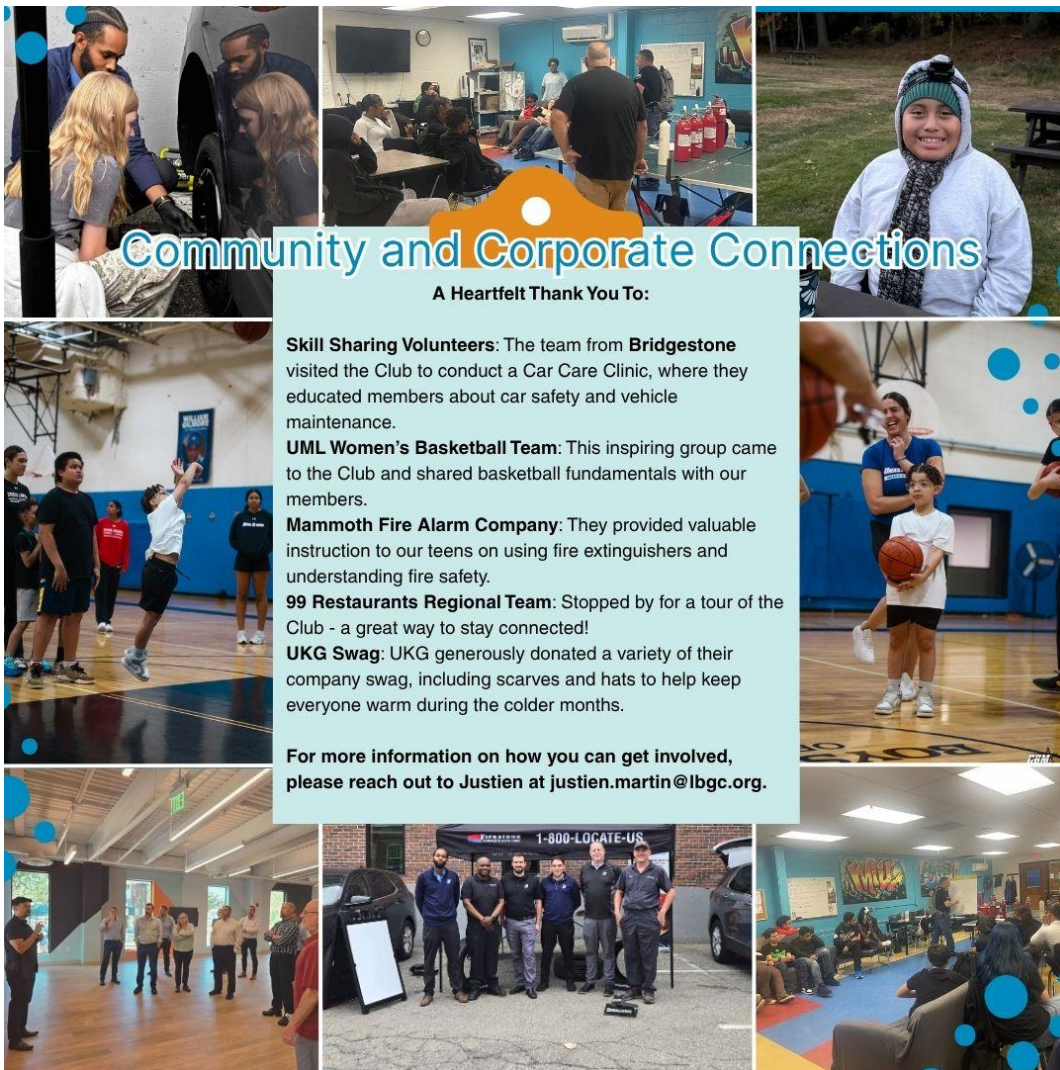
Several key provisions of the 2017 Tax Cuts and Jobs Act are scheduled to expire after December 31, 2025. This could mean significant changes to tax deductions, estate tax exemptions, and overall giving strategy.

Now is an ideal time to consider making a gift (including through a Donor-Advised Fund), multi-year pledge or legacy commitment to Boys & Girls Club of Greater Lowell.

Options you may wish to consider:

- Make a single, larger gift in 2025.

- Make a larger contribution in 2025 that supports a multi-year commitment - fulfilling a long-term commitment now under favorable tax conditions.
- Include Boys & Girls Club of Greater Lowell in your estate plan through a bequest, charitable trust, or beneficiary designation, potentially locking in higher exemption limits.
- Combine a planned gift with a current contribution to see the impact of your giving today while planning for tomorrow.
